<b>Muscle Attachments-Mandibular</b>				
Type A-adequate attached mucosa				
Type B-no b attach mucosa (22-27), +mentalis m				
Type C-no ant b&l vest (22-27), +genio & mentalis m				
Type D-att mucosa in post only				
Type E-no att mucosa, cheek/lip moves tongue
